Copyright Transfer Agreement

Because of the U.S. copyright law that went into effect January 1, 1978, The Society of Naval Architects and Marine Engineers requires a copyright assignment for papers that are published under the Society's purview to avoid an exposure to risks. This copyright assignment includes all derivatives and translations in English and in foreign translations, in all formats and media of expression now known or later developed, including electronic, as well as for individual sale, to the Society of Naval Architects and Marine Engineers. While it is necessary that the Society maintain copyrights for its publications, the author (s) retains the following rights:

- (1) all proprietary rights other than copyright, including patent rights;
- (2) the right to make oral presentations of this material; and
- (3) the right to reproduce figures and extracts from the paper with proper acknowledgement.

For papers written as a condition of employment, this form must also be signed by the employer's representative. For papers written as the result of a U.S. Government contract, or if the author(s) is a Federal employee, copyright is neither possible nor required; nevertheless, the author(s)' signature is required to affirm that the paper is cleared for public release, that the paper is original, and that the author(s) has obtained permission to use any previously copyrighted material, which are necessary conditions for all publications.

No paper can be considered for publication by the Society without a properly executed copy of this form; however, if the paper is not accepted for publication, this agreement is nullified.
