### MARINE SALVAGE ENGINEERING

#### BIO/Background:

Prior to joining The Glosten Associates, Matt Miller served for two years on board the 210 foot Coast Guard cutters *Venturous* and *Steadfast* as Damage Control Assistant and Electrical Assistant. After completing his graduate studies at the University of California, Berkeley, Matt worked for 4-1/2 years at the U.S. Coast Guard Marine Safety Center (MSC) in Washington, D.C. He was a Staff Naval Architect and Salvage Engineer, and served as the Assistant Salvage Team Leader where he responded to over 50 vessel casualties with 6 on-scene responses. He co-authored a SNAME annual meeting paper that documented work with panel testing that originated from barge casualties in the Gulf of Mexico. Matt has provided salvage engineering services for 8 vessel casualties while at Glosten.
