THE ANNUAL BANQUET, FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 2013**

The Society of Naval Architects and Marine Engineers (SNAME) will recognize four individuals for their outstanding contributions to naval architecture, marine engineering or ocean engineering and ship research. The annual achievement medals will be presented at the SNAME Annual Banquet, on Thursday, November 7, 2013, held in conjunction with the SNAME 2013 Annual Meeting and Expo in Bellevue, Washington.

The David W. Taylor Medal for notable achievement in naval architecture and/or marine engineering will be presented to **Dr. Jeom Kee Paik**, Professor, Department of Naval Architecture and Ocean Engineering, Pusan National University, Korea.

The Vice Admiral “Jerry” Land Medal for outstanding accomplishment in the marine field will be presented to **Christopher J. Wiernicki**, President and CEO, American Bureau of Shipping (ABS).

The William H. Webb Medal for outstanding contributions to education in naval architecture, marine or ocean engineering will be presented to **Dr. Henry S. Marcus**, Professor Emeritus, Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

The Blakely Smith Medal for outstanding accomplishment in ocean engineering will be presented to **Carl Arne Carlsen**, Sr. Vice President, Det Norske Veritas.
